Dear Parents/Carers

Coronavirus

A press conference was held by the Prime Minister, the Chief Scientific and Medical Officers yesterday, who set out a new approach with regards to the Coronavirus. Please see [here](#) to watch the press conference in full.

As a result, people are now being asked to stay at home for 14 days if they or a member of their household have either:

a high temperature – 37.8°C or above
a new continuous cough

- Please do not bring your child to School with a cough or a fever of 37.8°C or above. If the school staff identify a cough or fever you will be asked to take your child home and be asked to keep your child at home for 14 days.
- If your child develops a cough whilst at School that is new and continuous or a high temperature of 37.8°C or more, you will be asked to collect your child immediately and your child will then be required to stay at home for 14 days.

We hope that the measures outlined in this letter will help to reassure you that we are following official guidance and managing the situation professionally and appropriately.
